ENTRY FEE: A \$35.00 fee is required to have items judged. Each entry includes 1 table and 2 chairs. Each paid contestant will be limited to two entries per category. **All entries must be received by April 1, 2019.** Additional table and chairs are available for \$35.

SALES: Will be permitted. Our emphasis, however, is on showing - not selling. No tools, knives, or cutouts may be sold by anyone other than our vendors. It is the responsibility of the seller to comply with the Iowa Sales Tax laws.

GENERAL: Table covering and skirting are required. Tables are 6' x 30".

The lighting is adequate, but supplemental lighting may be desirable. This is the exhibitors' responsibility. Please check your registration form if you would like electricity.

Blue Ribbon Carvings in previous Iowa State Woodcarvers shows are not eligible for competition.

Carvers are required to leave their carvings on display until 4:30 Sunday.

No Power Carving. The dust and the noise are offensive to some people.

JUDGING: There will be three judges. All entries must be in the judging room by 9:00 AM Saturday. During judging no one will be allowed in the Judging Room except the Show Room Committee.

BANQUET: A banquet will be held Saturday night at 5:30 p.m. at **Waterloo Center for the Arts**. All club members, exhibitors and guests are welcome. Reservations are required and must be paid in advance by April 1st. Winners will be honored and the Carver's Choice Award will be presented. Vendor gifts will be awarded.

SECURITY: Show area is locked before and after show hours. However, neither the Waterloo Center for the Arts nor the Northeast Iowa Woodcarvers accepts or implies any liability for loss or damage.

FUN CLASS: This will be a carving project to be announced and carved at the show. Please indicate on the entry form if you are interested in participating. There will be ribbons.
